

Sources of Hope:

The generosity of our parishioners helped to uplift our parish this year. The record-breaking 2022 Diocesan Lenten Appeal supported outreach to seniors, the needy in our community, and the sick and homebound. As the number of homeless rises in Western Pennsylvania, we will continue to need your support.

Thankfully, our parish and our Altar Rosary Society are once again able to fundraise. This year, our Lenten Fish Dinners were a great success. It was wonderful to see our parish family working together again in service to the community.

On June 12, we were blessed to have our very own Father Thomas Skamai celebrate his Thanksgiving Mass in our parish. He was ordained to the priesthood on May 14 for the Congregation of the Oratory of Saint Philip Neri in Pittsburgh. The last priest ordained in our parish was Father Fidelis Levri in 1967. He has been a member of Glenmary Mission since 1980. They are both blessings in our parish, and we are grateful for their response to the call of priestly service. They serve as an inspiration for us to be open to God's calling by sharing our gifts and talents in our parish community.

We do have some future events on the calendar, so please consider participating:

November 2022 – Angel Giving Tree in cooperation with Armstrong County Children and Youth, which fulfills the wishes of needy families in our community.

Dec. 4, 2022 – Christmas Cash Raffle will conclude as the winning tickets are drawn following the 11 a.m. Mass. Proceeds will benefit the upkeep and maintenance of our parish facilities.

December 2022 - Angel Memorial Tree, with ornaments that can be purchased and hung in memory or in honor of a loved one. This is done during the Advent season.

Jan. 1, 2023 – In celebration of the feast day of our parish patron, Mary Mother of God, we will have a parish family day to honor our Blessed Mother.

Jan. 8, 2023 – Epiphany play presented by our faith formation children after the 11 a.m. Mass. This will be a true celebration of the Light of Christ present in our families and in our world.

I want to call your attention to the National Eucharistic Revival, a three-year initiative to show as many people as possible what wonders the True Presence of Jesus can do to heal the heart and soul. Look for more information about adoration and reconciliation opportunities locally to help confront the hardships that we face in everyday life. The National Eucharistic Revival is a powerful, uplifting way to rise to these challenges. As a way to involve our families, our Faith Formation program plans to offer an activity each month that will center on building family faith and on the Eucharist.

Capital Improvements:

Your contributions to our parish help maintain the facility, making it the center of prayer in our community. Over the last two years, the following projects were accomplished: the church exterior was power washed; landscaping between the upper parking lot and Second Street was done; repair, sealing and line painting of the parking lots were completed; four new doors were installed in the basement and at the church side entrance; and one new air conditioning unit was installed and another was repaired. Plans are underway to repair the choir loft church window and its surrounding structures.
